Rock Island County Treasurer, Louisa Ewert, announces that she has been notified by **Triumph Community Bank (now TBK)** that their financial facilities within Rock Island County will no longer collect *Real Estate property taxes*. Unfortunately, it means that their “own” customers will no longer be able to make tax payments at any of their 10 Illinois **Triumph Community Bank (TBK)** branches. Last year over 8,250 tax payments were conveniently made by their own customers and local residents for this service. Unfortunately, this type of cost savings at the expense of personal service to their customers is typical when merged into larger financial institutions. This ends a relationship that began many decades ago, formerly with both Metro Bank and THE National Bank.

Many “local” Banks and some Credit Unions will continue to collect Rock Island County taxes as they have in the past! Payments can also be made by mail (postmark accepted), in person at our office, dropped in the 24 hour box in front of the County Building, sign up for automatic withdrawal from a checking or savings account or pay online at www.rockislandcounty.org (fees apply)
