INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING PLEADING GUILTY AND REQUESTING COURT SUPERVISION

You have been given this form by the officer who issued you the traffic citation you received, as you may be eligible to plead Guilty and receive Court Supervision without appearing in person in court. For instructions on pleading Guilty without Court Supervision, or pleading Not Guilty, please review the back of the actual ticket the officer issued you.

If you wish to plead Guilty and receive Court Supervision without a court appearance, you may do the following:

1. Read the form.
2. Determine if you satisfy the criteria for receiving Court Supervision through the mail. You must have received only one ticket which indicates at the bottom "No Court Appearance Required", your ticket if for speeding, must be for 20 miles per hour or less over the speed limit, you must not have received Court Supervision for any moving traffic offense within the last 12 months, and you must be 21 or older.
3. After reading this form and determining that you are eligible and want to plead Guilty and request Court Supervision, fill in all of the blanks on the forms, including method of payment.
4. Mail the completed forms and payment to the Rock Island County Circuit Clerk, P. O. Box 5230 Rock Island, IL 61204-5230, at least one week before the appearance date on your ticket. You may also bring the completed forms and payment to the Rock Island County Courthouse, 210 15th Street Rock Island, IL, one business day before the appearance date noted on your ticket.

Drivers under 21 or those who do not meet the criteria for Court Supervision by mail, may still appear in court on the appearance date set forth on your ticket and ask for Court Supervision.

Note: If your request for Court Supervision is denied, you will receive in the mail a notice to appear in court in person.

Plea of Guilty and Affidavit for Court Supervision State of Illinois, 14th Judicial Circuit, County of Rock Island

I hereby certify under penalty of perjury pursuant to 735 ILCS 5/1-109 as follows:

I am eligible for Court Supervision without a Court Appearance as I am charged with a single traffic ticket which indicates on the bottom, "No Court Appearance Required". I have not been convicted of or placed on Court Supervision in any court for a violation of any state statute or municipal ordinance which is a moving (reportable) offense to the Secretary of State during the 12 months preceding the date of this plea. I hereby plead Guilty to the offense charged on the traffic ticket. I understand that I have the right to have an attorney to represent me on this charge. I understand that I have the right to have a trial by judge or jury. I understand that at either of those trials, I would have the right to be present, see the State's witnesses and evidence, confront them and cross-examine them, call witnesses on my own behalf, testify on my own behalf and remain silent and say nothing. I understand that if I exercise my right to a trial the State would be required to prove me Guilty beyond a reasonable doubt. By signing this document, I understand I am pleading Guilty and giving up all the aforementioned rights, and further understand that if I violate the law for another moving (reportable) traffic offense within the 90-day period for which I have been granted Court Supervision, that it may be revoked and a conviction entered against me upon notice to me and opportunity to be heard, and reported to the Secretary of State. I further understand that if my request for Court Supervision is denied, I will receive in the mail a notice to appear in court in person.

If you are charged with a violation that **does not** require a court appearance (Supreme Court Rule 529a), you may plead guilty and pay such violation by mail, the internet, or in person at the Clerk's Office. Complete this form **ONLY** if you are eligible for court supervision. Drivers under 21 cannot use this form to request Court Supervision.
