Rock Island County property owners have until Tuesday, November 17th, 2020 to pay the fourth, and final installment of 2019 Real Estate property taxes. If taxes are not paid on time, taxpayers must pay a 1.5 % penalty per month until paid or sold.

Payments may be made at the County Office Building 1504 3rd Ave Rock Island in the County Treasurer's Office from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Mon.-Fri. There is 24 hour Drop Box in front of the County Office Building.

Due to COVID-19 we discourage in-house payments (social distancing in line and mask is required) To avoid anticipated long lines, taxpayers are urged to pay by mail, online or use 24 hour drop box! Payments bearing a U. S. Postmark up to and including Tuesday, November 17th, 2020 will be accepted without penalty. Payments can also be made at most locally owned *Banks and some Credit Unions* in Rock Island County during regular business hours. When paying at a Bank, you must have entire statement including stubs. **Area Banks will not accept payments after the final due date of November 17th, 2020.** Online payments can be made without penalty up until 11:30pm on November 17th @ www.rockislandcounty.org by credit card, Visa debit or e-check. A convenience fee will be charged. **Online payments will not be accepted after November 17th, 2020.** New option this year "PAY BY PHONE" call 1-855-965-4400 (same fees apply)

Also Note:

Effective December 1st, 2020 only cash, cashier's check, certified check or money order will be accepted as payment.

Taxes not paid by Friday, December 4th, 2020 will be published in the paper as delinquent. (\$10.00 certified mailing & publication fee will also be added.)
