



PRESS RELEASE

Louisa A. Ewert, Rock Island County Treasurer, announces the mailing of **62,611** Rock Island County Real Estate tax bills totaling more than **\$271,421,194.44**. These statements will be mailed out Monday, May 10th, 2021. Taxpayers who have more than one parcel, may receive multi statements in one envelope. Four stubs are provided for those taxpayers using the four installment plan. Due dates this year will be June 10th, August 10th, September 10th and November 10th.

Payment(s) may be paid by mail; or in person at the County Treasurer's Office 1504 3rd Ave Rock Island; between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday except holidays. Payments can also be made at most locally owned Banks and now some Credit Unions in Rock Island County during regular business hours, with entire statement. We still offer automatic withdrawal tax payments. *As well as "pay property taxes online" through the Rock Island County website.* We also have a 24 hour "Drop Off Box" in front of the County Office Building for tax payments! Please visit our website at www.rockislandcounty.org for all tax information.

For those taxpayers who will be mailing or dropping off their tax payments at the Treasurer's Office, please include the numbered stub(s) for which you are paying. Taxpayers **who do not receive** a tax bill, yet are responsible for paying taxes, are urged to call the County Treasurer's Office at (309) 558-3510.

While State Law requires that at least the first installment of taxes are to be paid by June 10th to avoid penalties; payments bearing a postmark of June 10th, will be accepted as timely. Payments made in person after June 10th or bearing a postmark after June 10th will be subject to a penalty at the rate of 1.5 % per month or any part of a month as required by State Law.
